“Un Trésor à la Carte” : A charity auction for the benefit of the rescue at sea


Paris, November 29th, 2024 – The association SEAtizens.org is proud to announce the second edition of “Un Trésor à la Carte” (“A Treasure on the Chart”), a charity art auction to support sea rescue operations. The event will take place on December 3, 2024, at the Lafayette Anticipations Foundation in Paris and will also be streamed live via Drouot Live.

The aim of this auction is to support three key associations: three key organizations dedicated to saving lives at sea: SOS Méditerranée, the SNSM (French National Sea Rescue Society), and Navire Avenir. Every cent raised from this auction will go directly to these three organizations.

The event, hosted by the renowned auction house Millon, will feature over 50 unique artworks created by well-known artists. Each piece will be made on a maritime chart donated and signed by prominent sailors, merging the worlds of art and the sea to support life-saving missions.

A unique fusion of art and the sea

After its first edition in 2019, which raised almost 50,000 euros, “Un Trésor à la Carte” is a charity event combining the worlds of art and the sea. Participating artists are required to produce their work on a nautical chart donated by a sailor, making each piece a unique artistic and maritime creation.
